

Hermantown Elementary School Distance Learning Plan for Special Education

Purpose: During the COVID-19 outbreak, the State of Minnesota has closed the schools and is not permitting direct face to face Special Education services. Our Distance Learning Plan will be to offer Special Education services by either email, phone, Google Hangout Meet and/or SeeSaw.

- I. Instruction/Learning Frequency
 - A. All services providers will provide learning/instructional activities weekly.
 - B. If a family does not have digital access, the district will deliver the teacher provided materials to their home.
- II. Collecting Data and Progress Monitoring
 - A. The Special Education Team will be in contact with other services providers, daycares, parents, and other family members to assist in providing support, collecting data, and to show progress through phone/video conversation, Google forms, therapy notes, and emails.
- III. Weekly communication with parents will be done via email, phone, Google Hangout Meet &/or Seesaw
- IV. When the directive for school closure is discontinued and direct student service time is allowed, the services will be provided as noted in the IEP service grid.
